### Guiding Questions:

Why do people live where they do? (*Visual-spatial Intelligence*)

What are the main reasons why people settle in particular areas and form the beginnings of cities that we know today?

What keeps people in urbanized areas once these develop?

What would influence different people to live where they do?

In a two carefully planned full-page mind maps, show and explain why people in the **past** and **today** have settled and stayed in Japan, particularly in the region or near vicinity where Tokyo is now situated. You should include a title, diagrams, arrows, pictures, color, headings, and concise yet sufficient reasons and explanations. You consider the shape of the land and the places where most people live, the climate, and how needs were met (for early settlements), and further needs such as attractions, work, and lifestyle (for today). (Make sure you can explain at least 10 different ideas)
