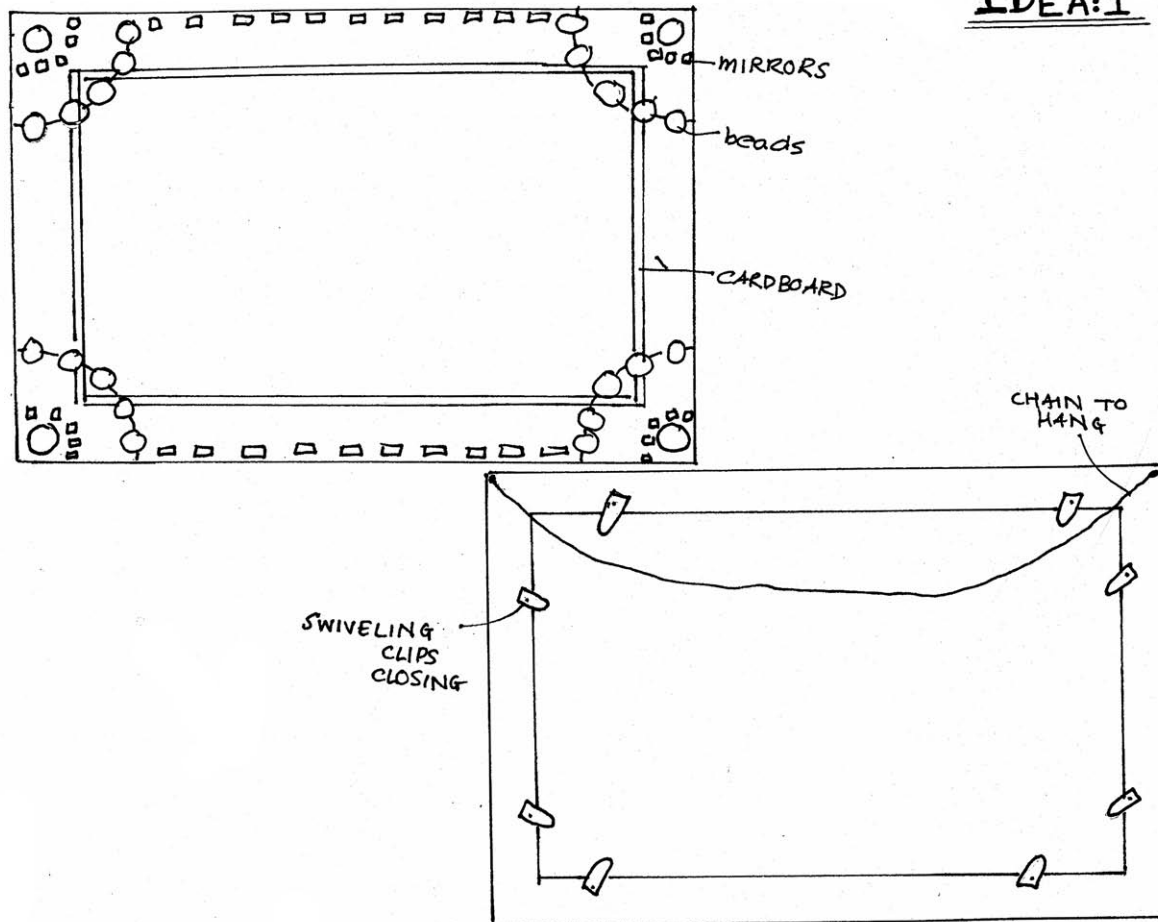


Criterion B: design**IDEA:1**

Advantages:

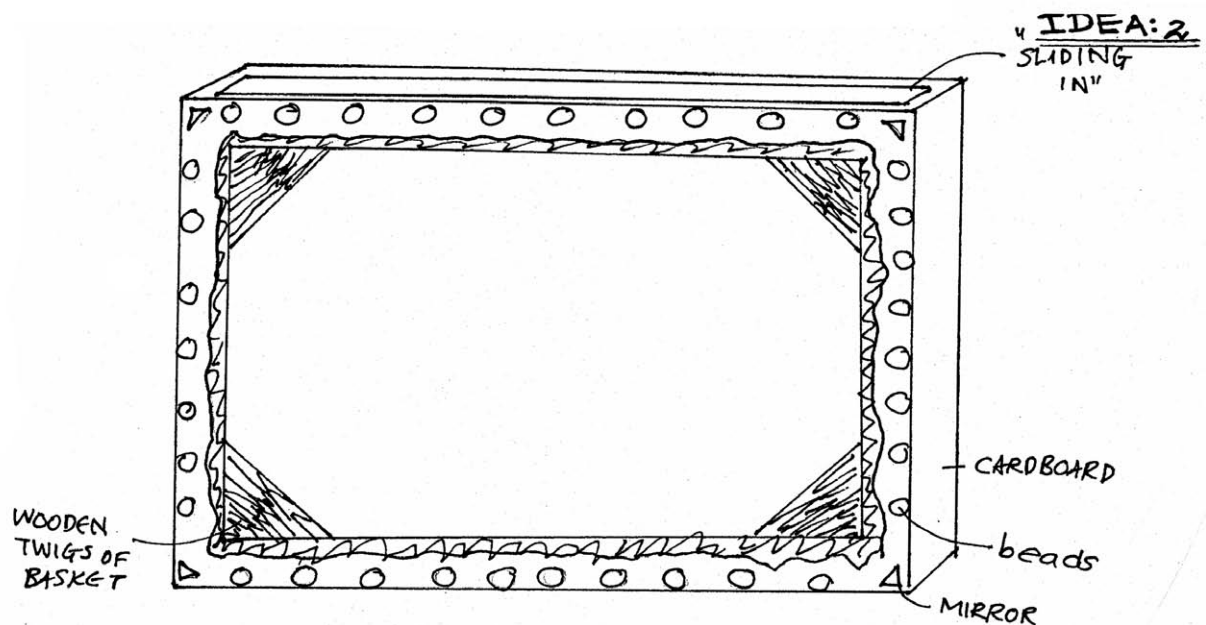
- 1) Creative idea

Advantages:

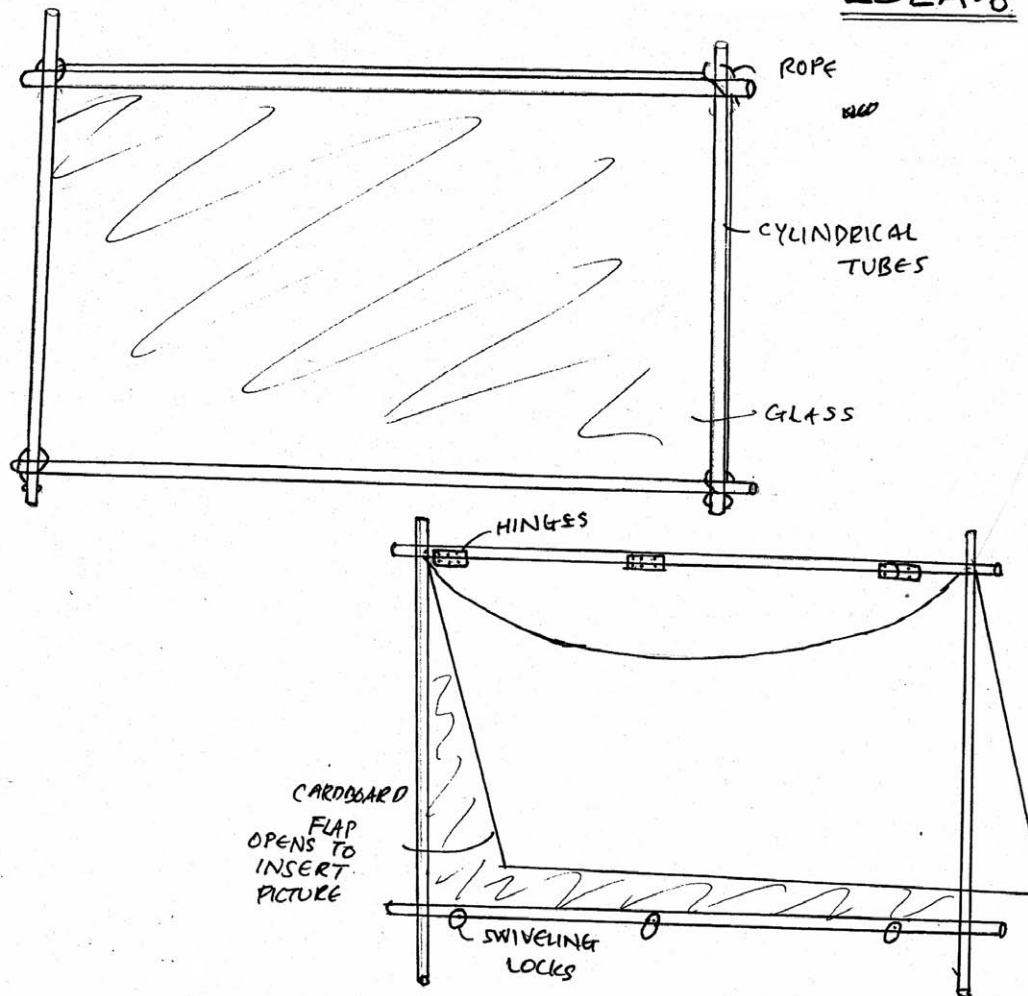
- 1) Creative idea

- 6) Is durable

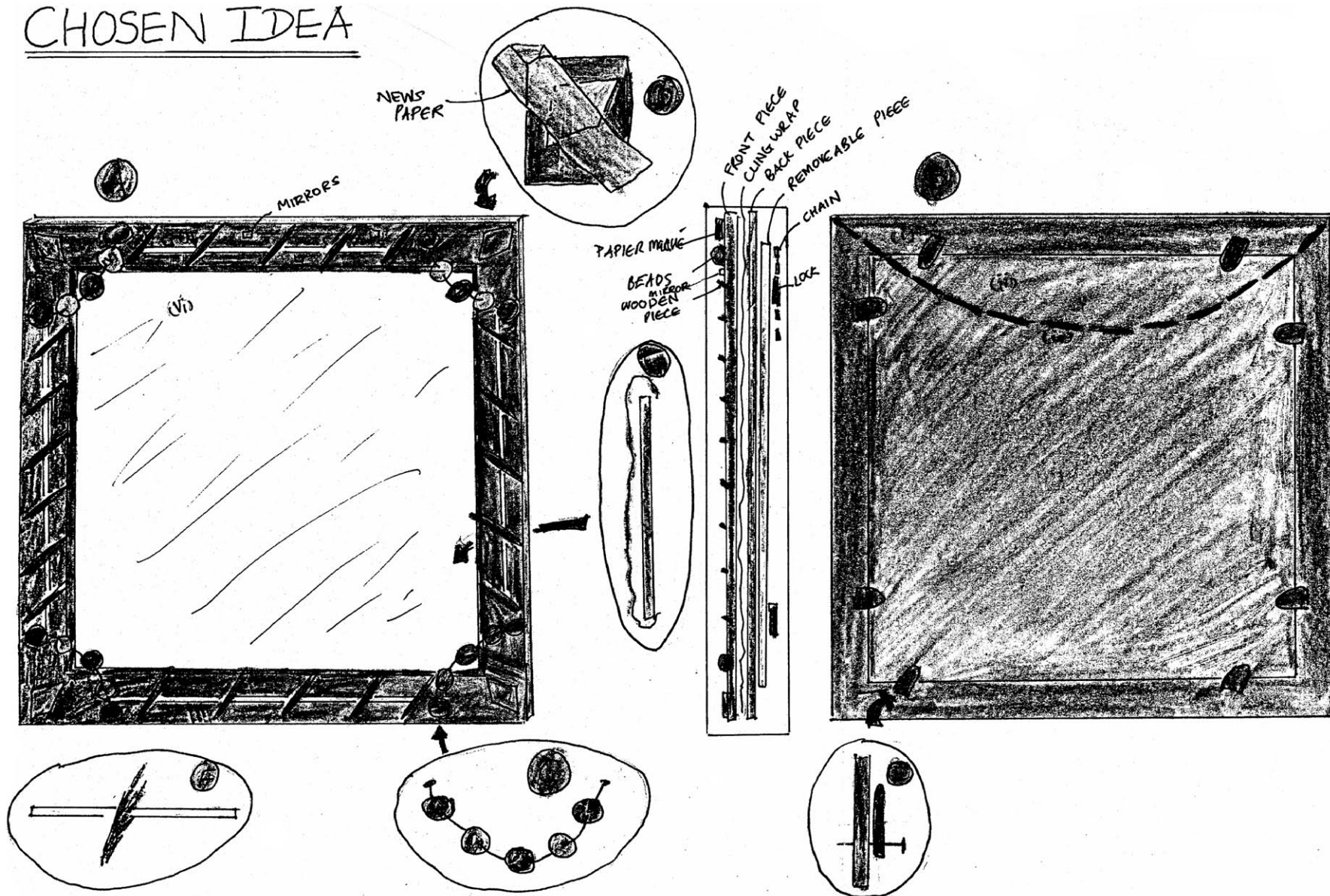
Disadvantages:

EXPLANATION OF DIAGRAM :

| PART | <u>LABEL</u> | <u>SPECIFIC LABEL</u> | <u>EXPLANATION</u> |
|---------------------------|---------------------|------------------------------|--|
| Frame (Front) | A | i | This is the part of the base material of the front of the frame, i.e. very hard cardboard. It should be brown colour. |
| | | ii | This is the papier mache pieces used for decoration. Pieces will be cut out out of cardboard. Diagram D shows how it will be put together. |
| | | iii | These are the wooden twigs which will be pulled off old baskets. They will be dipped into a colour, preferably white and arranged on the frame carefully. |
| | | iv | These will be match sticks, dipped in grey, and arranged along with the wooden pieces but in different positions.. |
| | | v | These are the beads, which will be strung onto threads. Scotch tape will be used to separate these beads. The beads row will then be stuck onto the borders of the front of the frame, as the diagram shows. |
| | | vi | This is the cling wrap. A good size of this will be pulled tight and wrapped onto the <i>back</i> of the <i>front</i> of the frame. |
| Back of Frame | B | i | The back piece of the frame. It consists of two parts. The border and the removable piece. It doesn't need a particular colour. |
| | | ii | This is the removable piece. It will be held down by the swiveling locks, which can be turned around in order to take out this piece and insert the picture. |
| | | iii | These are the swiveling locks. They will be made out of cardboard. They will be nailed into place as shown in diagram E. |
| | | iv | This is the chain to hang the picture, if a chain cannot be found, a strong rope can also be used. |
| Beads décor | C | - | There will be separations of each bead with a thick layer of scotch tape. The final beads will be stuck on lightly onto the ends of the frame. |
| Papier Mache décor | D | - | This is the demonstration of how the papier mache process will work. It shows a cardboard piece being covered by newspapers, and then with recycled paper. |
