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STEP-BY-STEP PLAN

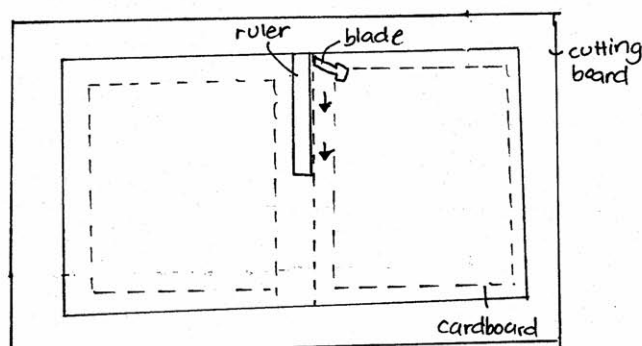
RECYCLING PROJECT

STEP 1:

The main piece of the project is the base, which will be the cardboard frame. First the front piece will be made by marking out 49X 49 cm. A 3cm border will be marked around this. The outer border will first be cut out with a sharp blade and ruler (a cutting mat placed beneath). After this is cut out, the border markings will also be cut out to leave the gap in the middle.

The same process will be repeated with the back piece which will also be 49X49 cm, but the border cut out will be 2.5cm.

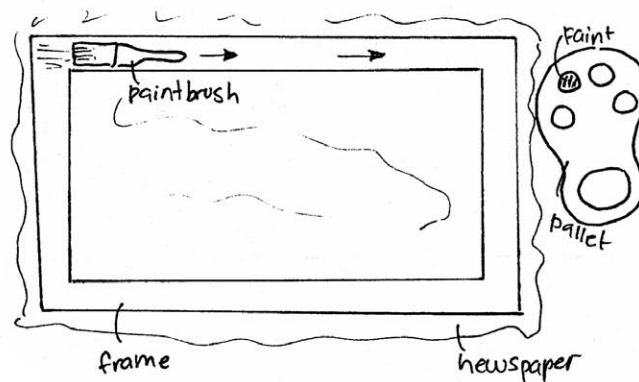
This process will take a whole lesson, as cutting the cardboard will be very difficult with the blade.



STEP 2:

The border will be given a light tone of brown colour. This will be done by taking a little paint, and mixing a little water with it to dilute it. A thick paintbrush will be dabbed in the paint and will be run along once on the front part of the frame border to give only a light shade of the colour. When the entire front piece has been painted in this way, it will be left to dry.

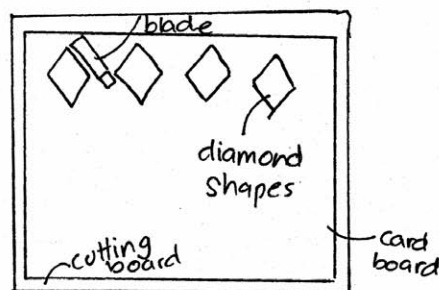
This process will take 20 minutes to do, and then it must be left to dry which will take another 15 minutes. In the mean time I can proceed to step 3.

**STEP 3:**

On cardboard material 4 diamond pieces will be marked out. Each will be 2.5 cm long. They will be cut out using a blade in the same manner as mentioned previously.

After cutting out the pieces, they will be given a contrasting shade of brown colour paint. After painting the pieces, they will be left to dry.

Marking then cutting out the diamond pieces will take 20 minutes. Painting the 4 pieces will take 15 minutes. After this they will be left to dry. In the mean time I can proceed to step 4.

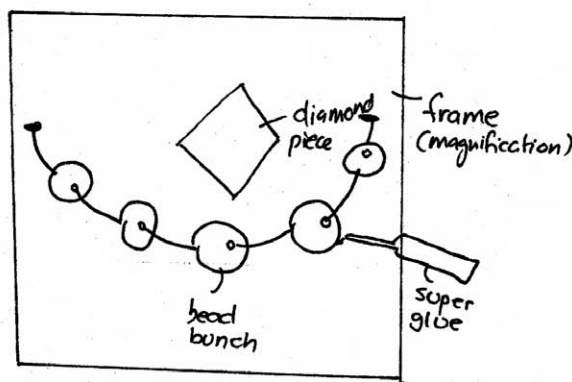


STEP 9:

4 pieces of brown thread will be cut out. Take first string, and tie a thick knot at one end. Insert 5 beads and secure the pack by tying a knot on the other end. The same will be done with the 3 other strings.

Now, the beads pack will be placed in a curved shape (as shown in diagram) in the corner. Positioning the beads properly, they will be stuck down with super-glue (normal glue will not be strong enough for this). When this is done, the same will be repeated with the remaining three bead packs.

This process will take 1 lesson and half of the next lesson.



- When this is all finished, the process will be over. If there is any time, I may consider decorating it a little more or make a few changes to make it look more attractive. But this is not very important as the present décor is also very attractive, so it is not priority at present.
- Also note, that more information about attachments and create process such as sizes etc. has been given in the development.
