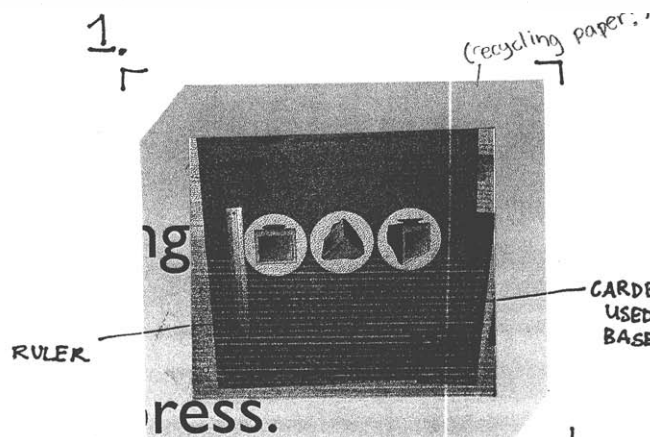
## RECYCLE PROJECT ~FRAME~

**DAY: 1****DATE:** 1/4

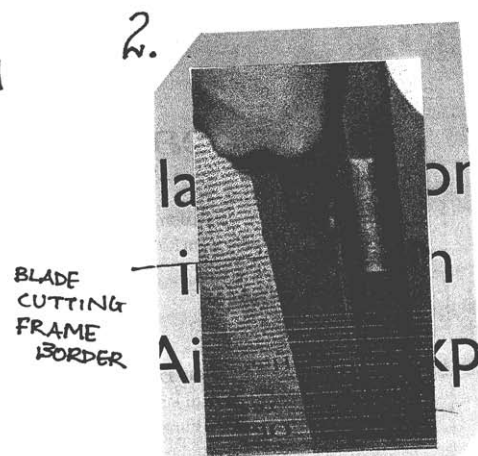
**PLAN:** For the main base of the frame, i.e. the border, I am using an old carton. Today, I will mark then cut out the frame border as per step by step plan.

**CHANGES:** No changes made to design plan. But did not manage to finish cutting out frame, as it was a little difficult.

**TO DO NEXT:** Cut out inner frame on one of the boards. Make edges smooth and clean.

THE BLADE WAS RUN ALONGSIDE THE RULER AND THE BORDER CUT OUT

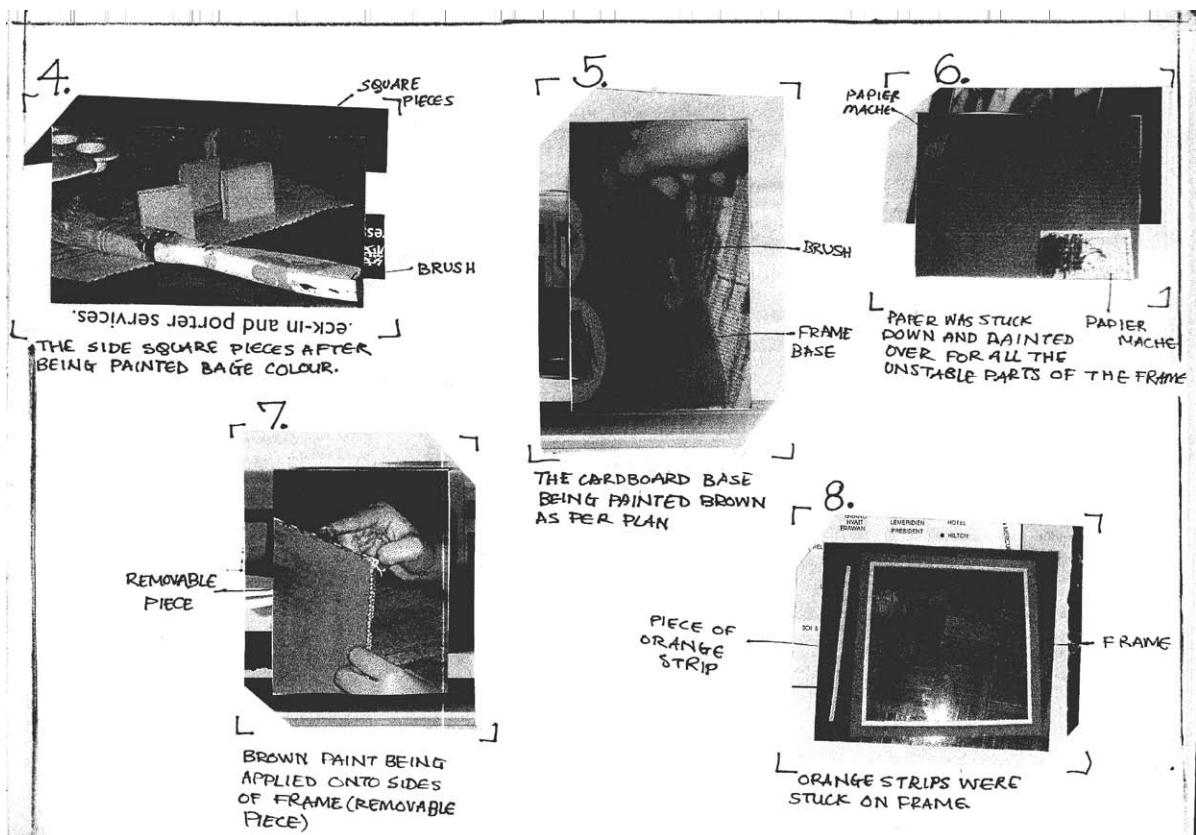
**DAY: 3****DATE:** 8/4

**PLAN:** Paint entire frame border and base with brown "paste paint". It provides a powdery effect which I felt would help enhance the "old" look I had planned to achieve earlier in my plan.

**CHANGES:** Two changes made to design plan:

1. I was planning to make the frame base a light brown. But instead I made the base the darker brown and have planned to make the decorations on top of it light.
2. I used old an old project-poster and made an inner border to enhance the looks. Also because there were some very untidy cuts and bits protruding out that could not be made smooth. I am still facing this problem on the outer border as well.

I also cut out small square pieces (which I had initially planned to be diamond pieces but I decided against because it didn't look very neat) while the frame was left to dry.



**DAY: 11****DATE:** 31/4**PLAN:** I need to make, paint and attach the swivel pieces at the back.**CHANGES:** I finished cutting out the pieces. Then I made one change. I felt the pieces were not strong enough and also not very attractive, so I stuck paper around the edges of the pieces and then painted it (papier mache). I then realised that it looked much better so I used the same method to make smooth the borders of the frame. Initially I had a problem because pieces were sticking out, so I stuck paper over the edges and painted over. The edges now look clean.**TO DO NEXT:** The last part. To make a string for the back to hang up the frame**DAY: 12****DATE:** 31/4**PLAN:** I have strings which have fallen off cushion covers. I will tie two of those together to make a hanging for the back. I will thread the ends of the string into the two loop screws.**CHANGES:** No changes made to original design plan. I attached hanging behind.**TO DO NEXT:** The project is complete. I will now need to evaluate it.
